2017 Phillips 66 Big 12 Men's Basketball Championship

- WVU's No. 2 seed marks the second straight season that WVU has been seeded No. 2 in the Big 12 Championship.
- Bob Huggins has posted a 41-18 mark in conference tournaments, including 10 championships in four different leagues.
- Jevon Carter was named the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Year, while Tarik Phillip was named the Big 12 Sixth Man of the Year. Carter was named to the All-Big 12 Second team, while Nathan Adrian was named to the All-Big 12 Third Team. Carter and Adrian were named to the All-Big 12 Defensive Team. Carter is just the third player in Big 12 history to earn three selections on the All-Big 12 Defensive Team.
- WVU's 24 regular season wins matches the school record for regular season wins (2016, 2010, 1989 and 1982 teams).
- WVU has won at least 25 games for the third season in a row. Huggins now has 17 seasons of 25 wins or more.
- WVU is 34-22 in March under Bob Huggins, and WVU is 49-29 in its last 78 games in the month of March.
- Bob Huggins became the 10th NCAA Division I head coach to win 800 games on Dec. 17 against UMKC.
- Bob Huggins is in eighth place all-time on the NCAA Division I winningest coaches list. His record now stands at 816-328. Huggins is tied with Rollie Massimino and trails Jim Phelan by 14 wins.
- Huggins is the third-winningest active Division I coach behind Mike Krzyzewski and Jim Boeheim.
- On March 3, Huggins was named one of 10 semifinalists for the Naismith Coach of the Year.
- WVU did not lose a regular season game this season by double digits for the first time since the 1961 season.
- WVU had back-to-back seasons of single-digit season losses. The last time that happened was in 1982-83.
- WVU is 36-18 in the Big 12 regular season in the last three seasons. WVU is 75-26 overall since the beginning of 2014-15.
- West Virginia is 157-36 in its last 193 games against unranked teams, including 82 of its last 93 at the WVU Coliseum.
- Bob Huggins has wins over 38 ranked teams at WVU, including 14 wins over Top 10 teams and three over No. 1.
- WVU became the first team since Indiana in 2011-12 to beat No. 1 and No. 2 in the same season.
- WVU is the fourth team in AP history to beat an AP No. 1 and AP No. 2 by at least 15 points each in a single season.
- WVU's 21-point win over No. 1 Baylor was the eighth-largest margin victory ever against a No. 1-ranked AP team.
- WVU is 7-3 in its last 10 games vs. AP Top 25 teams, with two wins over No. 1, one vs. No. 2 and two wins over No. 6.
- Jevon Carter became West Virginia's 51st 1,000-point scorer on Feb. 27. He has scored 145 points and has grabbed 56 rebounds over the last eight games, shooting 50 percent or better in six of those eight games.
- WVU had seven different players lead the team in scoring in Big 12 games this season.
- WVU leads the country in turnover margin (8.8), turnovers forced (21.2) and steals (10.9). WVU ranks third in scoring margin (17.0), fourth in offensive rebounds (14.5), 12th in assists (17.1) and 15th in scoring offense (83.8).
- WVU's plus/minus leaders are Tarik Phillip (+375), Jevon Carter (+365) and Nathan Adrian (+335).
- WVU is averaging 41.4 deflections per game, while averaging 35.1 deflections in Big 12 Conference games.
- Baylor's 29 turnovers were the most forced by WVU in a league game in 24 years (30 vs. St. Bonaventure in 1992).
- The Mountaineers are forcing their opponents to turn it over on 28.2 percent of their possessions, tops in the country.
- WVU has nearly forced more turnovers (671) than its opponents have made field goals (709).
- WVU has attempted 351 more shots than its opponents this season -- 2,037 to 1,686.
- The Mountaineers have been ranked 78 weeks in the AP poll under Bob Huggins, including 31 weeks in the AP Top 10. Huggins has had WVU ranked more weeks than any other coach in school history.
- Dating back to last year, WVU has been ranked for 34 consecutive weeks in the AP poll and 51 of the last 54 weeks in the AP rankings. WVU has been ranked 54 consecutive weeks in the USA Today Coaches poll.
- This is WVU's second longest streak of ranked weeks in the AP poll, behind 56 weeks from March 1956 to March 1960.
- The Mountaineers have won 59 of their last 60 games when holding opponents to 69 points or less.
- WVU is 180-30 under Huggins when holding opponents to 69 points or less. WVU has won 69 of its last 71 and 125 of its last 136 games when holding opponents under 69 points.
- West Virginia has made at least one 3-point field goal in 590 consecutive games.
- West Virginia has allowed its opponent to shoot 50 percent or better only 57 times under Bob Huggins (343 games).
- West Virginia is 60-3 under Bob Huggins when shooting 50 percent or better from the field.
- West Virginia is 176-32 under Bob Huggins when leading at halftime.
- West Virginia is 184-19 under Bob Huggins when leading by 10 or more points in a game.
- West Virginia is 156-11 under Bob Huggins when posting a higher shooting percentage than its opponent.
- The Mountaineers are 167-32 under Bob Huggins when scoring 70 or more points in a game.
- West Virginia is 165-40 under Bob Huggins when outrebounding its opponent.
- WVU is 7-4 all-time on March 10 and 216-159 all-time in the month of March.

Series Record Against Kansas State

- West Virginia and Kansas State will be meeting for the 13th time in series play that began in 1949.
- The first meeting took place in Morgantown on Dec. 12, 1949, with the Wildcats coming away with a 49-44 victory.
- West Virginia has won six of the last seven meetings.
- This season, West Virginia won in Morgantown, 85-66 on Feb. 11 and fell to K-State in Manhattan, 79-75 on Jan. 21.
- West Virginia is 6-4 against the Wildcats since the Mountaineers joined the Big 12 in 2012.
- Bob Huggins is 7-5 against his former team (7-4 at WVU). His Akron team fell to the Wildcats, 70-68, on Dec. 10, 1988.
- Bob Huggins led K-State to a 21-12 record in 2006-07, the Wildcats' most wins in 19 years. K-State broke an eight-season postseason drought when Huggins led the Wildcats to the NIT Second Round. The Wildcats also collected 10 Big 12 wins for the first time since the league's inception in 1997.

Phillips 66 Big 12 Men's Basketball Championship Notebook

- West Virginia is playing in its fifth Phillips 66 Big 12 Men's Basketball Championship.
- Coach Bob Huggins is 10-8 in conference championship play at West Virginia.
- Huggins is 4-5 in Big 12 Championship play. At Kansas State in 2006-07, the Wildcats defeated Texas Tech, 66-45, before falling to Kansas, 67-61. In WVU's first year in the Big 12, the No. 8-seeded Mountaineers fell to Texas Tech, 71-69. Three years ago, the No. 6-seeded Mountaineers fell to Texas, 66-49. Two years ago, the No. 5-seeded Mountaineers lost to Baylor, 80-70. Last year, the No. 2-seeded Mountaineers defeated TCU (86-66) and Oklahoma (69-67) before falling to Kansas (81-71) in the championship game.
- WVU's most recent conference championship came in 2010 when WVU won its first Big East Championship title after defeating Cincinnati, Notre Dame and Georgetown.
- West Virginia has reached the semifinals in five of its 10 conference tournaments under Bob Huggins.
- WVU has reached the semifinals in six of the last 13 conference championships with a Big East Championship finals appearance in 2005 and a tournament title in 2010.
- West Virginia has won 14 of its last 25 conference championship games, all of those coming since 2005.

WVU Basketball Tradition

- This is the 108th season and 114th year overall for West Virginia basketball, which began in 1903.
- The Mountaineers own a 1,727-1,066 all-time record in intercollegiate basketball competition, ranking the Mountaineers 23rd in wins among all Division I schools.
- WVU has earned 27 NCAA berths and 16 NIT trips since 1941, and has finished in the Top 25 19 times, including an amazing nine straight years from 1955-63.
- In the past 12 years, WVU has reached the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2015, NIT First Round in 2014, NCAA Second Round in 2012, NCAA Third Round in 2011, the NCAA Final Four in 2010, made the NCAA Tournament in 2009, reached the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2008, won the NIT in 2007, reached the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2006 and made it to the NCAA Elite Eight in 2005.
- In 1958, the Mountaineers finished the regular season ranked No. 1 in both polls and in 1959, West Virginia, led by All-America guard Jerry West, lost in the NCAA finals to California.
- West Virginia has had 11 first team All-Americans, headlined by West, who went on to become one of basketball's all-time greats with the NBA's Los Angeles Lakers.
- Most recently, Juwan Staten was named to the Lute Olson All-America team in 2015, Da'Sean Butler earned All-America first team honors in 2010 by John Wooden and *Basketball Times* and Kevin Jones earned All-America first team honors in 2012 by John Wooden.
- Besides West, some of basketball's biggest names have been affiliated with the Old Gold & Blue, including former Lakers coach and general manager Fred Schaus, former NBA President of Basketball Operations Rod Thorn and former Utah Jazz broadcaster and NBA Hall of Famer "Hot Rod" Hundley.
- West Virginia has played in four different home venues: the ROTC Armory (1903-15), The Ark (1916-27), Stansbury Hall (1928-69) and the WVU Coliseum (1970-present). When the WVU Coliseum was closed due to asbestos removal during the 1999-2000 season, WVU played home games in Charleston, Wheeling and Fairmont.
