QUICK HITTERS

- No. 21/25 West Virginia (2-0) closes out its three-game homestand with Coppin State on Saturday. The Mountaineers and Eagles (0-3) meet for the ninth time in program history, with WVU winning the previous eight matchups. WVU prevailed 96-64 in the matchup last season on Nov. 16, 2015.
- With a victory on Saturday, coach Mike Carey will collect his 325th career win at West Virginia. Carey is the program's all-time wins leader.
- Sophomore Tynice Martin netted a career-high 27 points and four other Mountaineers eclipsed double figures in WVU's 95-49 win over Howard on Tuesday. Guard Chania Ray also reached a career-high with 17 points.
- Lanay Montgomery leads the nation with 15.5 rebounds per game. She grabbed 18 in the win over Charleston Southern and added another 13 in the victory over Howard.
- WVU travels south to the Savannah Invitational from Nov. 22-24.

SCOUTING CSU

- Coppin State (0-3) completes a four-game road trip on Saturday versus WVU. The Eagles fell 77-46 to George Washington on Wednesday. Other losses include a 73-44 loss at VCU and a 103-40 setback to Virginia.
- Freshman Chance Graham was named the MEAC Rookie of the Week on Monday. Graham averaged a double-double of 10 points and 10 rebounds vs. VCU and Virginia.
- Keena Samuels leads the Eagles with 11.7 points per game, while Graham is the team's top rebounder with 8.7 rebounds per contest.
- CSU is averaging 43.3 points per game and shooting just 25.7 percent (45-of-175) from the field. The Eagles are shooting 9.8 percent (4-of-41) from behind the arc and are outrebounded by 21.0 boards per game.
- DeWayne Burroughs enters his first year as head coach at CSU. Last season, he served as head coach at the District of Columbia.

LAST TIME OUT

- West Virginia overcame a slow shooting first half to shoot 64.7 percent in the third and 41.5 percent in the fourth quarter to roll to a 95-49 win over Howard.
- Five Mountaineers reached double figures including Tynice Martin with a career-high 27 points. Chania Ray also inked a personal-best 17 points, followed by 13 from Alexis Brewer, 12 from Kristina King and 11 from Teana Muldrow.
- Lanay Montgomery narrowly missed her second double-double of the season, grabbing a team-high 13 rebounds and scoring seven points in 20 minutes of action.

THIRD QUARTER SUCCESS

- West Virginia has outscored its opponents by a combined 65-32 in the third quarter this season.
- Against Charleston Southern, the Mountaineers outscored the Buccaneers 33-14 and shot 61.1 percent (11-of-18) from the field.
- In Tuesday's win over Howard, WVU shot 64.7 percent (11-of-17) and outscored the Bison 32-18. WVU has now allowed more than 18 points in a quarter this season.

ALMOST HEAVEN, WEST VIRGINIA

- West Virginia has won a school-record 26 consecutive nonconference games inside the WVU Coliseum dating back to Nov. 24, 2013.
- The Mountaineers' last loss against a nonconference opponent at the WVU Coliseum came to Ohio State on Nov. 8, 2013, with WVU falling 70-61.
- The previous record of 19 lasted from Dec. 30, 2008 to Jan. 2, 2011.
- West Virginia is 98-7 (.933) at home against nonconference opponents since 2002.
- WVU has registered nine undefeated seasons at home against nonconference competition in 15 years under Mike Carey.

NATIONAL LEADERS

- While it is still early in the season, West Virginia sits in the top 15 in multiple statistical categories.
- WVU is No. 3 in scoring margin (+48.0), No. 4 in field goal percentage defense (24.1%), No. 6 in rebound margin (+24.5), T-11 in scoring defense (43.5 ppg) and No. 14 in scoring offense (91.5 ppg).
- Lanay Montgomery leads the nation with 15.5 rebounds per game and is fifth nationally with seven offensive rebounds.
- Chania Ray is eighth nationally with 8.0 assists per game.

WVU CLIMBS TO NO. 21

- West Virginia moved up to No. 21 in the Associated Press Poll released on Monday.
- WVU remains No. 25 in the USA TODAY SPORTS Coaches Poll released Tuesday.
- The Mountaineers were in both preseason polls for the fourth time. Other years include: 2014-15 (17 AP/17 Coaches), 2010-11 (11 AP/11 Coaches) and 2007-08 (18 AP/20 Coaches).
- WVU was tabbed to finish fourth in the Big 12 coaches preseason poll.
- Other Big 12 Top 25 teams include: Baylor (2/4), Texas (8/10), Oklahoma (16/17) and West Virginia (21/25).

STREAKS OF NOTE

- Lanay Montgomery has blocked at least one shot in 26 consecutive games and 38 out of the last 39.
- West Virginia's Tynice Martin has reached double-figure scoring in 10 of her last 12 games, including the last three contests.
- Martin has made a field goal in 12 consecutive games, while Teana Muldrow has connected on at least one bucket in the last 11 games.
- Muldrow has made six consecutive three-pointers dating back to last season's Ohio State NCAA Tournament game.
- Martin has connected on 13 consecutive free throws dating back to the Princeton game on March 18, 2016, in Columbus, Ohio.
- West Virginia has held its last three opponents below 40 percent shooting: Ohio State (37.1%), Charleston Southern (17.7%) and Howard (32.0%).

MARTIN FINDING RHYTHM

- Sophomore Tynice Martin has been on fire since Feb. 13, 2016. The sophomore has reached double-figures in 10 of the last 12 contests, including three consecutive.
- During that stretch, Martin is averaging 14.8 points per game.
- Martin's career-high 27 points against Howard (Nov. 15) is the most for Mountaineer sophomore since Bria Holmes tallied 28 points against Texas Tech on Feb. 26, 2014.
- The Atlanta native is just the third WVU sophomore to finish perfect from the line in double figures after she went 10-of-10 from the charity stripe against Howard (Nov. 15).

AN IMPRESSIVE DEBUT

- West Virginia scored 88 points against Charleston Southern on Nov. 12, and outscored an opponent by 50 points for the first time since beating Saint Francis by 55 in Dec. 2014.
- The Mountaineers held CSU to just 11 made field goals, matching the 11 they held Longwood to last season.
- West Virginia has held opponents to 11 or fewer made field goals 17 times since 2002 - all during the Mike Carey era.

CREDENTIALS

Photographers and media members who wish to cover a game at the WVU Coliseum should contact women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance. Credential pickup is located at the Gold Gate and opens one hour prior to each game.

GAMEDAY

Parking is free and open to the public in the Coliseum parking lot. Parking passes will be provided for only games that coincide with WVU men's basketball games.

The working press area is located on the east side of the main floor at concourse level (22 rows from the playing floor). Press should enter through the Gold Gate with their credentials. Forty-eight seats are available for working media; four television slings are also available. West Virginia grants broadcast rights to the official radio outlet of the visiting team on reciprocal basis.

Accredited photographers may work along the playing floor at both baselines behind the restriction line established by the NCAA. Outline writers or equipment carriers are not permitted on the playing floor.

The WVU Coliseum also supports wireless internet access. Please see women's basketball contact Russell Luna for login and password information.

Complete statistics are provided to all working media at halftime and postgame. Requested team members and coach Carey will be available for interviews following a 15-minute grace period.

DURING THE WEEK

Any member of the media wishing to interview a player or member of the coaching staff during the week should contact West Virginia women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance.

Cell phone numbers will not be made available and all WVU student-athletes have been instructed to not conduct interviews without prior approval of the sports communications staff.

OPENING THE SEASON

- West Virginia women's basketball opened its 44th season on Nov. 12 with an 88-38 win over Charleston Southern.
- The Mountaineers own a 29-15 all-time record in season openers and have won nine out of their last 10.
- Coach Mike Carey has a 13-3 record in season openers.
- The Mountaineers are an impressive 34-10 in home openers.
- WVU has won 16 out of its last 17 home-opening affairs.

CAREY APPROACHING 325TH WVU WIN

- Coach Mike Carey is in his 16th season at the helm of the Mountaineer women's basketball program.

Montgomery Achieves Historic Feat in Opener

Senior Lanay Montgomery's recorded a historic performance of 17 points and 18 rebounds to pace the No. 22/25 ranked West Virginia University women's basketball team to a season-opening, 88-38, victory over Charleston Southern on Saturday.

West Virginia (1-0) sprinted out to an 11-5 lead before Charleston Southern (0-1) cut the game to 11-9 midway through the first quarter. WVU utilized a 12-2 run and held CSU scoreless for a seven minute stretch that lasted late in the second quarter and the first three minutes of the third quarter. The Mountaineers are now 13-3 all-time in season openers under Mike Carey and 29-15 all-time.

Montgomery was one of three WVU players to score 17 points in the contest and did something a Mountaineer had not accomplished in 25 years. The senior from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, connected a perfect 7-of-7 from the field and added 3-of-4 from the charity stripe in 21 minutes. Montgomery's impressive 17 point and 18 rebound performance was the best for a WVU women's basketball player since Donna Abbott posted 22 points and 19 rebounds against Rutgers on Feb. 28, 1991. The double-double marked the 10th in Montgomery's career and she has now pulled down double-digit boards in back-to-back games.

Overall, West Virginia connected on 50.8 percent (32-of-63) from the field and 39.1 percent from behind the arc (9-of-23). The Mountaineers held CSU to just 17.7 percent (11-of-62) shooting, as the Buccaneers became the 17th opponent in WVU program history to only make 11 or less field goals.

West Virginia outmanned Charleston Southern, 60-31, on the boards and outscored CSU 38-2 in the paint. WVU capitalized with 21 second chance points and 24 points off 16 Buccaneers turnovers.

Junior Teana Muldrow scored 17 points, collected seven rebounds, dished out three assists and snatched a pair of steals. Tynice Martin also eclipsed double figures with 17 points, making 7-of-13 from the field and 3-of-7 from the 3-point line.

Chania Ray distributed a career-high 11 assists - the most for a Mountaineer point guard since Linda Stepney recorded 12 against Saint Francis in Dec. 2014. Ray also registered four rebounds and two steals.

A couple of other Mountaineers reach career highs: Anja Martin tallied a personal-best eight points and Desiree Rhodes corralled a new career-high in 12 boards. Kristina King, the Big 12 Conference Preseason Newcomer of the Year, scored eight points in her WVU debut.

Martin's Career-High 27 Paces WVU Past Howard

Sophomore Tynice Martin netted a career-high 27 points to lead the No. 21/25-ranked West Virginia University women's basketball team to a 95-49 victory over Howard on Tuesday evening at the WVU Coliseum.

Howard senior Te'Shya Heslip's layup cut the WVU lead to 16-11 with 1:41 remaining in the first quarter. However, West Virginia answered with a 21-0 run that lasted six minutes into the second quarter.

The Mountaineers (2-0) tallied 54 of their 95 points in the second half to cruise to their 26th consecutive victory against a nonconference opponent at the WVU Coliseum.

Martin bested her previous career-high of 20 points and became the ninth WVU player to finish perfect from the free throw line with 10 or more points. The sophomore from Atlanta finished the evening 7-of-14 from the field, 3-of-9 from behind the arc and 10-of-10 from the free throw line. She grabbed four rebounds, collected three steals, dished out two assists and blocked two shots in 29 minutes.

In addition to Martin, four other Mountaineers eclipsed double-figures. Junior Chania Ray netted a career-best 17 points, going 7-of-14 from the field, while dishing out five assists and snatching a career-high five steals.

Alexis Brewer connected on a career-best three triples and finished 5-of-9 with 13 points. Big 12 Preseason Newcomer of the Year Kristina King tallied 12 points and corralled six rebounds. Teana Muldrow finished with 11 points, eight rebounds four assists and three steals. Lanay Montgomery blocked a shot for a 26th straight game and registered her third consecutive double-figure rebounding game with a game-high 13 boards. The senior scored seven points, just three shy of a double-double.

Overall, WVU shot 46.3 percent (31-of-67) from the field and 43.5 percent (10-of-23) from behind the arc. From the charity stripe, WVU knocked down 23-of-29 free throw attempts for 79.3 percent. Howard was limited to 32.0 percent shooting (16-of-15) from the field and 3-of-15 (20.0 percent) from behind the arc. The Mountaineers won the rebound battle, 48-28 and outscored Howard 32-18 in the paint. WVU forced 27 Howard turnovers and converted those into 34 points.
