QUICK HITTERS

- A season-high 34 bench points helped West Virginia to a 66-61 win over Ole Miss in the SEC/Big 12 Challenge on Sunday. The Mountaineers have won 30 consecutive games at the WVU Coliseum against nonconference opponents and 11 straight at home.
- Kristina King matched a season-high 16 points and grabbed a season-best nine rebounds in the win. Alexis Brewer added 12 points and Tynice Martin had 10.
- Martin continues to lead the Big 12 with 19.0 points per game. Lanay Montgomery, named to the NCAA's Weekly Starting Five, leads WVU with 10.0 rpg and 3.2 bpg.
- No. 13/14-ranked WVU has held its last 10 opponents to less than 40 percent shooting from the field, including Ole Miss, which shot at a 32.2 percent clip.
- West Virginia and USC Upstate (4-5) meet for a second time on Saturday. WVU won the previous meeting, 75-45, at the WVU Coliseum on Nov. 17, 2012.
- WVU has its highest ranking the AP Poll and USA TODAY Coaches Poll since 2013-14.

SCOUTING UPSTATE

- USC Upstate (4-5) has lost two of its last three games, but is coming off a 92-50 win over Bob Jones on Dec. 3.
- The Spartans are averaging 62.8 points and allowing 55.2 points per game. USC Upstate is shooting 37.1 percent (209-of-564) from the field and holding opponents to 37.1 percent (189-of-510) shooting.
- Upstate is 16th nationally with 105 steals this season and ranks 15th in the NCAA with a +7.67 turnover margin. The Spartans are 11th in the NCAA with 13.2 fouls per game.
- Raven Jefferson is USC Upstate's lone double-figure scorer, averaging 13.8 points per game. Jefferson dropped a career-high 30 points in the win over Bob Jones. She leads the team with 22 steals and 17 made three-pointers.
- A'Lexxus Davis paces the Spartans with 5.4 rebounds per game in eight contests.

LAST TIME OUT

- West Virginia used a season-high 34 points from its bench to collect a 66-61 win over Ole Miss in the SEC/Big 12 Challenge.
- Preseason Big 12 Newcomer of the Year Kristina King matched a season-high with 16 points and grabbed a season-best nine rebounds to lead the Mountaineers. Alexis Brewer added 12 points and Tynice Martin collected 13 points in the win.
- WVU has won 30 consecutive games against nonconference opponents at the WVU Coliseum and 11 straight at home.
- With Ole Miss shooting just 32.2 percent from the field, WVU has held its last 10 opponents to less than 40 percent shooting.
- WVU's 43 FG attempts were the lowest since shooting 43 vs. Georgetown in 2011.

A BLAZING START

- West Virginia (9-0) has matched its third-best start in program history. The team went 9-0 to tip off the 2004-05 season.
- West Virginia opened the 2010-11 campaign with a 16-0 start for the best opening in program history.
- With a win on Saturday, WVU can match the second-best start in program history of 10-0 which occurred in the 2002-03 season.
- West Virginia's top-four starts are all under coach Mike Carey.

PHYSICAL FOR 40

- West Virginia has limited its first nine opponents this season to less than 40 percent shooting and four of those less than 30 percent: Charleston Southern (17.7%), Howard (32.0%), Coppin State (22.6%), NC A&T (32.2%), ECU (35.8%), Auburn (27.6%), High Point (35.6%), Morehead State (29.4%) and Ole Miss (32.2%).
- Through nine games, opponents are shooting just 29.2 percent (155-of-530).
- WVU has converted 176 opponent turnovers (19.6 TOPG) into 201 points (22.3 ppg) this season.
- The Mountaineers have 90 steals (10.0 spg) on the season and reached double-digit steals in 5-of-9 games.
- The 11 field goals for Charleston Southern marked the 17th time in program history that WVU has held an opponent to 11 or fewer field goals in a game since 2004.
- In the win over Coppin State, WVU's 14 blocks were the 10th-most in program history and the highest since deflecting 14 against Temple on April 1, 2015.
- The most points allowed in a quarter this season was 24 against NC A&T on Nov. 22.
- ECU was limited to four points in the fourth quarter, tying a record-low for points scored in a quarter by a WVU opponents.

ALMOST HEAVEN, WEST VIRGINIA

- West Virginia has won a school-record 30 consecutive nonconference games inside the WVU Coliseum dating back to Nov. 24, 2013.
- The Mountaineers last loss against a nonconference opponent at the WVU Coliseum came to Ohio State on Nov. 8, 2013, with WVU falling 70-61.
- The previous record of 19 lasted from Dec. 30, 2008 to Jan. 2, 2011.
- West Virginia is 102-7 (.936) at home against nonconference opponents since 2002.
- WVU has registered nine undefeated seasons at home against nonconference competition in 15 years under Mike Carey.
- WVU's current 11-game win streak at the WVU Coliseum is tied for seventh all-time.

THE THREE MOUNTAINEERS

- West Virginia's three Ms (Tynice Martin, Lanay Montgomery and Teana Muldrow) provide the bulk of the Mountaineers' offense with an average of 43.3 points scored per game.
- Martin leads the Big 12 with 19.0 points per game. She has reached double-figures in 11 consecutive games dating back to March 18, 2016. Martin has made a field goal in 19 consecutive games.
- Muldrow is second on the squad with 13.4 points per contest and 9.2 rebounds per game. Muldrow's rebound average is fourth in the league. Muldrow has made a field goal in 18 consecutive games.
- Montgomery is second in the Big 12 with 10.0 rebounds. She leads the league with 3.2 blocked shots per game and 4.2 offensive rebounds per game.
- Montgomery and Muldrow have combined for six double-doubles this season, including back-to-back double-double games against High Point and Morehead State.
- The duo are the first Mountaineer tandem since Takisha Granberry and Liz Repella in November 2008 to record double-doubles in back-to-back games.

NATION'S BEST

- West Virginia sits in the top 10 nationally in four statistical categories.
- Through games on Dec. 7, WVU is second nationally in field goal percentage defense (29.2%), second in blocked shots per game (7.3 bpg), seventh in scoring margin (+27.4, and ninth in scoring defense (51.3 ppg).
- Chania Ray is 26th nationally and second in the Big 12 with 6.0 assists per game.
- Tynice Martin paces the Big 12 and is 41st in the NCAA with 19.0 points per game.
- Lanay Montgomery's 3.2 blocked shots per game are first in the league and eighth nationally.
- Montgomery leads the Big 12 and ranks 27th in the NCAA with 4.2 offensive rebounds per game.
- She is second in the league with 10.0 rebounds, which ranks 30th nationally.

CREDENTIALS

Photographers and media members who wish to cover a game at the WVU Coliseum should contact women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance. Credential pickup is located at the Gold Gate and opens one hour prior to each game.

GAMEDAY

Parking is free and open to the public in the Coliseum parking lot. Parking passes will be provided for only games that coincide with WVU men's basketball games.

The working press area is located on the east side of the main floor at concourse level (22 rows from the playing floor). Press should enter through the Gold Gate with their credentials. Forty-eight seats are available for working media; four television slings are also available. West Virginia grants broadcast rights to the official radio outlet of the visiting team on reciprocal basis.

Accredited photographers may work along the playing floor at both baselines behind the restriction line established by the NCAA. Cutline writers or equipment carriers are not permitted on the playing floor.

The WVU Coliseum also supports wireless internet access. Please see women's basketball contact Russell Luna for login and password information.

Complete statistics are provided to all working media at halftime and postgame. Requested team members and coach Carey will be available for interviews following a 15-minute grace period.

DURING THE WEEK

Any member of the media wishing to interview a player or member of the coaching staff during the week should contact West Virginia women's basketball contact/associate director of athletic communications Russell Luna at least 24 hours in advance.

Cell phone numbers will not be made available and all WVU student-athletes have been instructed to not conduct interviews without prior approval of the athletic communications staff.

A TIME CRUNCH

- West Virginia has led for 345 minutes and 3 seconds out of 360 minutes in the first nine games. WVU has only trailed for a total of 3:44 - :13 seconds vs. Howard; 1:35 against Auburn and :35 seconds against Morehead State; 1:21 vs. Ole Miss.

INDIVIDUAL STREAKS OF NOTE

- Laney Montgomery has blocked at least one shot in 44 of the last 47 contests.
- Montgomery has at least one rebound in 83 consecutive games and has made a free throw in nine straight contests.
- Teana Muldrow has a rebound in 46 consecutive games and a block in seven straight contests.
- West Virginia's Tynice Martin has reached double-figure scoring in 17 of her last 19 games, including the last 10 contests.
- Martin has made a field goal in 19 consecutive games, while Muldrow has connected on at least one bucket in the last 18 games.

WVU CRACKS TOP 15

- West Virginia moved up three spots in the Associated Press poll to No. 13 on Monday and to No. 14 in the USA TODAY Sports Coaches Poll on Tuesday.
- It marks the highest rankings since finishing No. 7 in the AP Poll and No. 12 in the coaches poll at the end of the 2013-14 season.
- The Mountaineers were in both preseason polls for the fourth time. Other years include: 2014-15 (17 AP/17 Coaches), 2010-11 (11 AP/11 Coaches) and 2007-08 (18 AP/20 Coaches).
- WVU was tabbed to finish fourth in the Big 12 coaches preseason poll.
- Other Big 12 Top 25 teams include: Baylor (3/3), Texas (17/17) and Oklahoma (19/20).

SAVANNAH INVITATIONAL CHAMPS

- Laney Montgomery's layup with 12 seconds remaining gave the Mountaineers the go-ahead bucket in a 56-52 win over Auburn to clinch the Savannah Invitational Championship on Nov. 24.
- Tynice Martin was named the Savannah Invitational MVP and Teana Muldrow garnered all-tournament accolades.

KING FINDING A RHYTHM

- Kristina King, the Preseason Big 12 Newcomer of the Year, has reached double-figure scoring in four games this season, including scoring 16 points in wins over East Carolina and Ole Miss.
- King has grabbed five or more rebounds in seven of nine games this season
- Also, King has made 34-of-59 from the field for 57.6 percent shooting, which ranks second on the team behind Laney Montgomery.

MARTIN ON A ROLL

- Sophomore Tynice Martin has been on fire since Feb. 13, 2016. The sophomore has reached double-figures in 17 of the last 19 contests, including 10 consecutive.
- During that stretch, Martin is averaging 16.9 points per game (304 points in 18 games).
- This season, she is averaging 19.0 points per game, which leads the Big 12.
- West Virginia is 5-0 when Martin scores 20 or more points in a game.
- She netted a career-high 28 points and matched a career-best nine field goals in the win over North Carolina A&T on Nov. 22. Martin added another 27 points against Howard on Nov. 15. Martin tallied 21 points in the win over High Point (Nov. 27).
- Martin averaged 20.0 points, 3.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists in the Savannah Invitational to earn MVP honors - the first regular-season tournament accolade in her career.
- Martin made 30 consecutive free throws from March 18, 2016 to Nov. 24, 2016 - the second longest streak in program history.

MONTGOMERY MAKING HER MARK

- Center Lanay Montgomery opened her senior season with a bang, scoring 17 points and grabbing 18 rebounds in the win over Charleston Southern (Nov. 12).
- Montgomery's 17/18 performance is the best for a Mountaineer since Donna Abbott inked 22 points and grabbed 19 rebounds against Rutgers Feb. 1991.
- She joined Georgeann Wells (1984) as the only Mountaineers to score 20+, rebound 18+ and block 5+ in a game.
- Montgomery tallied a career-high 23 points, grabbed 18 rebounds and blocked six shots against Morehead State on Nov. 30.
- On Dec. 7, Montgomery garnered NCAA Weekly Starting Five honors for her performance against Morehead State.
- Montgomery is third all-time at WVU with 260 career blocked shots. She is 11 away from reaching second place currently held by Asya Bussie (270).
- Montgomery's blocked shot total is sixth all-time in the Big 12.
- She has 715 total rebounds and is two away from reaching WVU's top 10.
- Additionally, Montgomery has corralled 250 career offensive rebounds, which is sixth. She is 15 away from reaching the top five.
- If trends continue, Montgomery can become the Mountaineers' best shooter in program history surpassing Olayinka Sanni (55.7%). Her career field goal percentage of 56.8% currently ranks first at WVU.
- Montgomery was named a nominee for the Allstate Good Works Team on Nov. 30.

Martin Nets Career-Best 28 in Return Home

Atlanta native Tynice Martin excelled in her return home to Georgia, scoring a career-high 28 points in the No. 19/23-ranked West Virginia University women's basketball team's, 80-64, win over North Carolina A&T on day one of the Savannah Invitational.

West Virginia (4-0) came out on fire with a 22-2 run in the first quarter. The Aggies (1-3) outscored WVU, 24-13, in the third quarter to trim the Mountaineer lead to 13. However, a 9-1 West Virginia run in the fourth quarter helped the Mountaineers squish the North Carolina A&T comeback attempt.

Martin made 9-of-15 from the field and finished with a career-best 28 points, while dishing out three assists and collecting two steals. She connected on 9-of-9 from the charity stripe, pushing her consecutive free throw streak to 28 makes since March 18, 2016.

Teana Muldrow added 15 points and corralled a season-high nine rebounds. Chania Ray added nine points and dished out six assists in the victory. Katrina Pardee and Kristina King each added eight points. Center Lanay Montgomery, largely limited due to foul trouble, finished with seven rebounds, four points and three blocks.

West Virginia shot 44.6 percent (25-of-56) from the field and 32.2 percent (19-of-59) from behind the three-point line. North Carolina A&T was the fifth straight Mountaineer opponent to shoot less than 40 percent, connecting on 19-of-59 for 32.2 percent. The Aggies made 6-of-13 from behind the arc for 46.2 percent.

The Mountaineers sprinted out to a 22-2 and held a 28-8 advantage at the end of the first quarter. In a stretch halfway through the quarter, Martin made four consecutive free throws and hit two jumpers as Pardee netted a triple to push the Mountaineers lead to 20.

The second half was much closer as the Aggies became the first WVU opponent to reach 20 points in a quarter this season. Montgomery and Muldrow were limited in the quarter with two fouls each. The Mountaineers led 52-28 at the break. WVU shot 51.5 percent (17-of-33) from the field compared to NC A&T's 23.5 percent (8-of-34).

It was a continuation of the second half for North Carolina A&T, as the Aggies jumped out on a 14-3 run to trim the game to 55-42 with 6:30 remaining. Dana Brown's jumper with 49.5 seconds left in the quarter cut the Mountaineer advantage to 65-52.

A 9-1 fourth quarter start extended the Mountaineer lead back to 21 points with 6:44 remaining. Montgomery and Ray made back-to-back layups followed by a Martin jumper. The exclamation point to the run was a Muldrow slicing layup that drew the and-one opportunity which she connected on to put WVU up 74-53.

Mountaineers Roll Past East Carolina

Teana Muldrow's double-double paced the No. 19/23-ranked West Virginia University women's basketball team to a 79-47 victory over East Carolina on Wednesday in the Savannah Invitational held at the Savannah Civic Center.

Three extended runs propelled the Mountaineers (5-0) to their fifth victory of the season. WVU used a 10-2 spurt in the first quarter, a 16-2 second quarter run and a 12-1 fourth quarter run to thwart the Pirates. East Carolina fell to 4-2 after being held to a season-low 47 points.

Muldrow, a junior from East Orange, New Jersey, recorded her second career double-double by scoring season-highs with 21 points and 10 rebounds.

Wednesday marked a breakout performance for Kristina King. The junior made 6-of-8 from the field and added four free throws for 16 points. King finished second in rebounds with eight.

Tynice Martin etched her seventh consecutive double-figure scoring game with 16 points. She grabbed six rebounds and collected two steals in 34 minutes. Chania Ray dished out four assists to lead WVU. Lanay Montgomery was limited for a second straight game due to foul trouble, scoring four points and pulling down three boards.

West Virginia made 29-of-60 from the field for 48.3 percent shooting and connected on 5-of-16 from 3-point range for 31.3 percent. ECU was held to 35.8 percent shooting (19-of-53) from the field, becoming the fifth WVU opponent this season to shoot less than 40 percent.

In the rebounds column, WVU outmanned ECU, 41-32, and outscored the Pirates 34-22 inside the paint. For a fourth game this season, West Virginia recorded double-figure steals with 11.

West Virginia opened the first quarter on a 10-2 run. ECU would use a 7-3 run to trim the Mountaineer advantage to 13-9. Teana Muldrow added back-to-back buckets to put WVU up 21-16 at the end of the quarter.

In the second quarter, West Virginia utilized a 16-2 run and held the Pirates for nearly a five minute stretch. Martin's layup with 1:08 on the clock gave WVU a 39-25 edge to end the half.

East Carolina trimmed the game to 12 points on multiple occasions in the third period. King snapped a three-plus minute scoring drought with five consecutive points. She picked up a steal and used the fast break to score the layup and connect on the and-one. King then hit another layup to extend the Mountaineer lead to 21 points.

WVU used a 12-1 in the fourth quarter capped by a Muldrow three-pointer to push the edge to 30 points.
